

DUNDONALD SHOW - SATURDAY 28th APRIL 2018 (Judge : Mr Richard Lanni)

The outdoor show season started as usual in Scotland at Dundonald Agricultural Show which is held at Dundonald Camp, Irvine. The judge for the driving classes on this occasion was Mr Richard Lanni from Perth.

5 turnouts came forward for Mr Lanni to judge on the day, one private driving turnout and four exercise turnouts. All 5 turnouts were called into the ring together to show Mr Lanni their paces on both reins before being lined up and inspected for cleanliness, fit and correctness of harness and carriage. Each turnout was then asked to perform an individual show for Mr Lanni.

The Private Driving Class was won by Caroline Watson from West Lothian driving her Welsh Section D Gelding, Llanarth Tango, to an original Dogcart by Mulliners of Birmingham dating from 1890.

The Exercise Class was then placed and was won by Carol MacAllister driving her Welsh Section C, Burghwallis Magic Moment to a Bennington Two Wheel Exercise Vehicle. In second place to Carol was Kendall Young driving her novice pony this year at only his second show, a coloured Welsh X called Bertie, also to a Bennington Two Wheel Exercise Vehicle.

The Championship and the Peter Findlay Peperual Trophy went to Caroline Watson with Llanarth Tango in her Original Dogcart by Mulliners of Birmingham and the Reserve Championship went to Carol MacAllister with Burghwallis Magic Moment in her Bennington Two Wheel Exercise Vehicle

The day finished off with a Style and Performance Class where competitors had 3 minutes to impress the judge with a show including some set movements. This class was also won by Caroline driving Llanarth Tango with Kendall Young and Bertie in second place.
