The first class of the day that Mr Lanni judged was the Open Private Driving. There were two turnouts forward. First place went to Gillian with The Longhouse Glam Rock with Caroline and Llanarth Tango in second place.

The next class was the Exercise Vehicle class which was won by Kendall Young with her Mule, Small Person driven to a Bennington Two Wheel Exercise Vehicle.

Next up was the Style and Performance class. With two forward, Caroline and Llanarth Tango and Kendall and Small Person, Mr Lanni had then do a display and the first place in this class went to Caroline Watson and Llanarth Tango with Kendall and Small Person in second place.

This was followed by the Registered Mountain and Moorland Class and Open Donkey or Mule Class. With just one turnout in each of these two classes Mr Lanni had Kendall and Caroline drive a musical ride style display with the two of them doing mirror image movements which was something different. So first place in the Mountain and Moorland class went to Caroline and Llanarth Tango and first place in the Donkey or Mule class went to Kendall and Small Person.

The Championship then took place with Gillian McNinch and The Longhouse Glam Rock being Mr Lanni's choice for Champion and Caroline Watson and Llanarth Tango in Reserve Champion.
