

AYR COUNTY SHOW – FRIDAY 13th APRIL 2016

The show season carried on to a cool but dry Ayr Show. This show is held in the centre of the racecourse with a large ring, plenty of space for parking and warming up.

The first class of the day was the Concours D'Elegance which was judged this year by Mrs Sandy Lanni. She had the pick of three traditional turnouts in her class and her choice on this occasion was Kim Pearson driving her Welsh Cob X Stallion JD's El Dorado put to a 1902 Beaufort Cart, in second place to Kim was Caroline Watson driving her Welsh Cob, Llanarth Tango driven to an 1890 Dogcart by Mulliners of Birmingham.

This was followed by Mr Richard Lanni judging the Open Private Driving. There were four lovely traditional turnouts forward and the Mr Lanni commended all the exhibitors on the standard of the turnouts forward and said they would stand in any line up at any show in the country and they were all of a very high standard.

Mr Lanni placed the Private Driving class and first place went to Gillian McNinch driving her coloured riding pony, The Longhouse Glam Rock to a Spindle Back Gig by Woodbeer Perriton of Whimble with second place went to Caroline Watson driving her Welsh Section D, Llanarth Tango to a 1890 Dogcart by Mulliners of Birmingham.

The next class in was the Exercise Vehicle class which was won by Miranda Saunders driving her new pony, CocoPops to a four wheel exercise vehicle.

The Championship then took place with Gillian McNinch and The Longhouse Glam Rock being Mr Lanni's choice for Champion and Caroline Watson and Llanarth Tango as Reserve Champion.
